

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## What is Unity Certified User (UCU)?

Unity Certified User (UCU) is the entry-level certification that demonstrates knowledge of Unity software and skills to create interactive, 2D and/or 3D experiences. Three UCU certifications are currently available – Programmer, VR Developer, and Artist. Differences in these certifications are outlined below.

- Unity Certified User: Programmer validates that the certified candidates have the basics of C# programming within Unity software. It also certifies the candidates' abilities to create 2D and 3D experiences within Unity.
- Unity Certified User: VR Developer validates candidates' abilities to create VR experiences and programs within Unity software.
- Unity Certified User: Artist validates that certified candidates have the basics of 2D and 3D digital artistry within Unity software. Certified candidates can successfully create digital art and other assets and implement them into virtual experiences.

## What are the benefits of earning Unity Certified User certification?

Skills to create immersive experience and work with AR/VR are in high demand. Unity Certified User serves as a tangible, industry-recognized proof to your technical and practical skills that are crucial to careers in this or related fields.

Certification is also valuable in bridging the gap between academia and industry, as it helps educators keep a curriculum relevant to today's job market.

## How is the certification earned?

Each Unity Certified User certification is earned by passing a 50-minute exam that is administered through a Certiport Authorized Testing Center (CATC). The exams are designed by industry experts, and are psychometrically validated, allowing for an authentic assessment of job-ready skills.

## What question formats are used in the exams?

The exams consist of scenario-based, selective response questions, including true or false, multiple choice, hot spot mapping, and matching.

Exams are delivered in person and online through Certiport Authorized Testing Centers (CATC). Yes, certifications become non-current three years after the date of issue.
